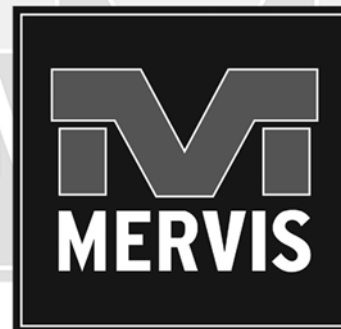

AUTHOR BIOGRAPHIES

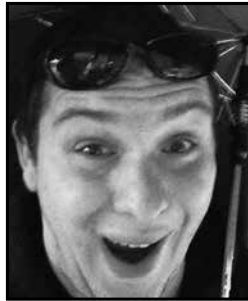
