

What can I say about this show? Let me start off by sharing what others have said. When you look up *Mamma Mia! the Musical*, you will see reviews that call it "A Global Smash Hit", "An unforgettable show with non-stop laughs and explosive dance numbers", and "An enchanting tale of love, laughter, and friendship", just to name a few. 
