YOUR GUIDE TO THE LANGUAGE OF OLIVER!

BEADLE: is a lay official of a church who may usher, keep order, make reports, and assist in religious functions; or a minor official who carries out various civil, educational, or ceremonial duties. Mr. Bumble is the parish beadle and leader of the orphanage.

BLOW: inform. Bill Sykes says, "You're blowed upon, Fagin!"

BOW STREET RUNNERS: London's police officers from that era (the early 19th century).

CADGE: To beg or get by begging. In "Food, Glorious Food," the orphans sing, "There's not a crust, not a crumb can we... cadge."

CHINA PLATE: Cockney rhyming slang for "mate" (friend). The Artful Dodger calls Oliver this upon their first meeting.

FLASH: showy, special. Dodger also calls Oliver "...me flash mate."

FURBELOW: A ruffle or flounce on a garment; a piece of showy ornamentation. In "It's a Fine Life," Bet sings, "No flounces, no feathers, no frills and furbelows. All winds and all weathers ain't good for fancy clothes."

JEMMY (British variation of US, jimmy): a short steel crowbar used, esp. by burglars, for forcing doors and windows. In "My Name," Bill Sykes sings, "With me jemmy in me hand, let me see the man who dares..."

LONG SONG SELLER: a street vendor who sold song sheets. These sheets were about one yard long with 3 columns of songs and advertised as 'three yards of songs for a penny', so they were long songs. One of the vendors in "Who Will Buy?" is a long song seller.

PEASE PUDDING: (also known as pease porridge) a thick savory pudding made from legumes, such as yellow split peas (kind of like hummus). From "Food, Glorious Food."

PLUMMY AND SLAM: all right. Nancy shouts this phrase as the password to enter Fagin's lair.

SAVELOYS: thick, bright red sausages. From "Food, Glorious Food."
