

A Note from the Director

From the Director, Chelsea Zych

In college, I fell in love with a little indie film called Camp. The narrative followed a band of misfit theater geeks devoting their summer to the dramatic arts, launching a new production every two weeks. Among the wide array of scenes and musical numbers presented (Follies, Dreamgirls, Company), one dance piece became my favorite: a crazy, frenetic number called "Turkey Lurkey Time" from Promises, Promises. This was my first exposure to the show you're about to see.

A few years later, the Broadway revival opened, featuring Sean Haves and Kristen Chenowith in the lead roles. I'm a fan of both performers, so I developed a renewed interest in the show, and the more I learned, the more enchanted I became. The script for Promises, Promises was adapted by Neil Simon, my favorite playwright. Burt Bacharach's score was bouncy, heartfelt, deliciously 60s. And the awards! Broadway legend Jerry Orbach had won a Tony and a Drama Desk award for the role of Chuck Baxter; the original cast recording took home a Grammy. I couldn't believe it had taken me so long to discover this little gem of musical theater. I decided it was time for two firsts: my directorial debut with DLO, and the Danville premiere of Promises, Promises.

You have to be a little crazy to take on theater as a hobby. It's hard work for no pay, and only fellow theater lovers will ever understand how two months of memorizing lines and music, pushing around set pieces, rearranging blocking, learning to dance, and doing it all at the same time could possibly be described as fun. For eight weeks, my wonderful cast and crew have done just that. It's been a labor of love, a true team effort, and the final product is a sexy, funny, challenging, and genuine piece of theater. I am so pleased to share this performance with you. Thank you for sharing in our madness, and enjoy the show.


