

Fairytales Do Come True!

Shrek is a fairytale unlike any other. If you've seen the movie, you already know the premise: ogre meets girl, ogre loses girl, girl turns into ogre, ogre and ogre live happily ever after. In *Shrek the Musical*, your favorite characters (Shrek, Princess Fiona, Donkey, Gingy and Lord Farquaad) come to life on stage, and fans of the movie will recognize many similar scenes and lines. What is different about the musical is the beautiful (and funny) music by Jeanine Tesori and David Lindsay-Abaire. These moments allow the characters to show more depth: the hardships of Shrek and Fiona's childhoods that lead to isolation in adulthood, the struggle of Donkey and the other fairytale creatures to accept their differences, and even Lord Farquaad addresses his "daddy issues." But, even though the show has a few serious moments, it is still heavy on the laugh factor! Shrek and Donkey exchange wisecracks, Shrek and Fiona fight in a style reminiscent of *Moonlighting*. Pinocchio and the fairytale creatures crack on their own backstories, and Lord Farquaad is a villain you'll love to hate! Combined with show stopping numbers, such as "What's up, Duloc?," "Forever," "Let Your Freak Flag Fly!" and "I'm a Believer," *Shrek the Musical* is entertaining for kids and adults alike. The sets, costumes, puppets, and special effects are sure to delight. The extremely talented cast, crew, and I have had such a great time putting this show together; we can't wait to present it to you! P.S.—Did I mention we have a 15-foot dragon?
