Sunday, November 18, 2012, 2:00 p.m. Monday, November 19, 2012, 6:30 p.m. If needed, callbacks by director invitation: Tuesday, November 20, 2012, 6:30 p.m.

Audition Info and Prep:

- 1. Please arrive promptly.
- An audition form will be available at the website, so it can be completed in advance, but there will also be forms available when you sign in.
- 3. Prep song of actor's choice (at least 32 bars or the whole song).
- 4. Actors should be able to harmonize.
- There will be a dance audition (nothing complicated, except for those auditioning for Pippi), so actors should dress comfortably (trashy, if they choose!).
- 6. There will be cold reading from the script.
- Under 18's may audition with parental permission (signature must be on audition form) and the understanding that this is a (hysterical) satirical comedy, intended for mature audiences, and contains strong language. This includes a few "f-bombs".

SPECIAL NOTES:

- Rehearsals will be scheduled Tuesday and Thursday evenings 6:30-9 p.m. (sometimes it may be 9:30) and Sunday afternoons 1-4 p.m. As we get closer to performance, if there is a need, we will add extra rehearsal time based on cast availability.
- All cast members are expected to assist with move in on Saturday, February 9, and strike on Sunday, February 17, after the show. Tech week (February 10-14) there will be rehearsals every night.
