Ever wondered what it's like to audition for a community theatre show? Are you curious about what a director might be thinking while you're auditioning? It's time to draw back the curtain and "Ace Your Audition".

Julia Megan Sullivan is pleased to partner with Danville Light Opera for three days of one-on-one audition coaching sessions. Actors of all ages (even younger than third grade) are welcome. Whether you're an experienced artist or just thinking about auditioning some time in the distant future, this is a great chance to practice when the stakes are low. (After all, she's not casting anything!)

The workshops will be held at Danville Light Opera's Center Stage rehearsal space in the Village Mall.

Two kinds of sessions are available:

For a \$5 donation to DLO, actors will have ten minutes to work on an audition song. An accompanist will be provided, but CD accompaniment is just fine. Looking for feedback on a new song you're considering using for an upcoming audition? Petrified to sing in front of people? Reserve a ten minute slot!

For a \$10 donation, actors who would rather not sing will have 20 minutes to work on a monologue. (Did you hear that? Non-singing actors are welcome even though these sessions will be held at DLO!) Singing actors can also choose a 20 minute slot to practice a song as well as reading from a script.

Want to be able to refer back to the session for continued growth as a thespian? Are you a parent looking to capture your talented child on video? Recordings of the session will be available! For an additional \$5 we will email you a private link to download your video. For \$7 we will send you the link as well as a copy of the video on a disc.

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
A Note from the Director

Prepare a song – accompanist provided or accompaniment CD (instrumental only – no vocals) may be used. Reading from script selections. Short group dance, so dress comfortably.

Auditions for Danville Light Opera's fall production of *Hello, Dolly!* will be held on Sunday, August 22 and Monday, August 23 at DLO's Center Stage rehearsal hall in the Village Mall. A large cast is needed to present this lively musical - from leading ladies to handsome gentlemen to townspeople, including children.

Auditions will be at 2:30 pm on Sunday and 6:30 pm on Monday. They will include singing your own song selection (please bring music or a accompaniment cd - no cd's with vocals or a capella singing - an accompanist will be available), reading from script selections, and a short group dance.

Rehearsals will generally be held Mondays and Thursdays from 6:30 -9:00, and Sundays from 2:00 - 5:00. Additional rehearsals will be scheduled as needed. Those auditioning should bring with them a list of schedule conflicts during the rehearsal period from August 26 to October 21. A script and chorus book is available at the Danville Public Library. Audition forms will be available soon on the DLO website at www.danvillelightopera.com.

Hello, Dolly! will be performed at 7:30 pm on Saturday, October 23 and at 2:00 pm on Sunday, October 24 in the Danville High School Auditorium. The directing team includes: Tom Fricke, drama director; Karen Grove, music director; and Cherie Turner, choreographer.

Everyone is encouraged to come out and audition for *Hello, Dolly!* on August 22 and 23.
