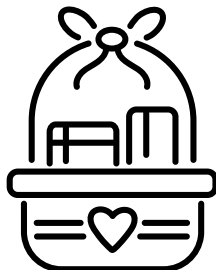
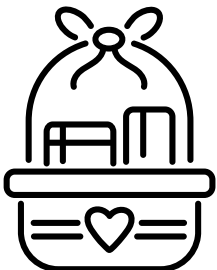

KADY RICHEY

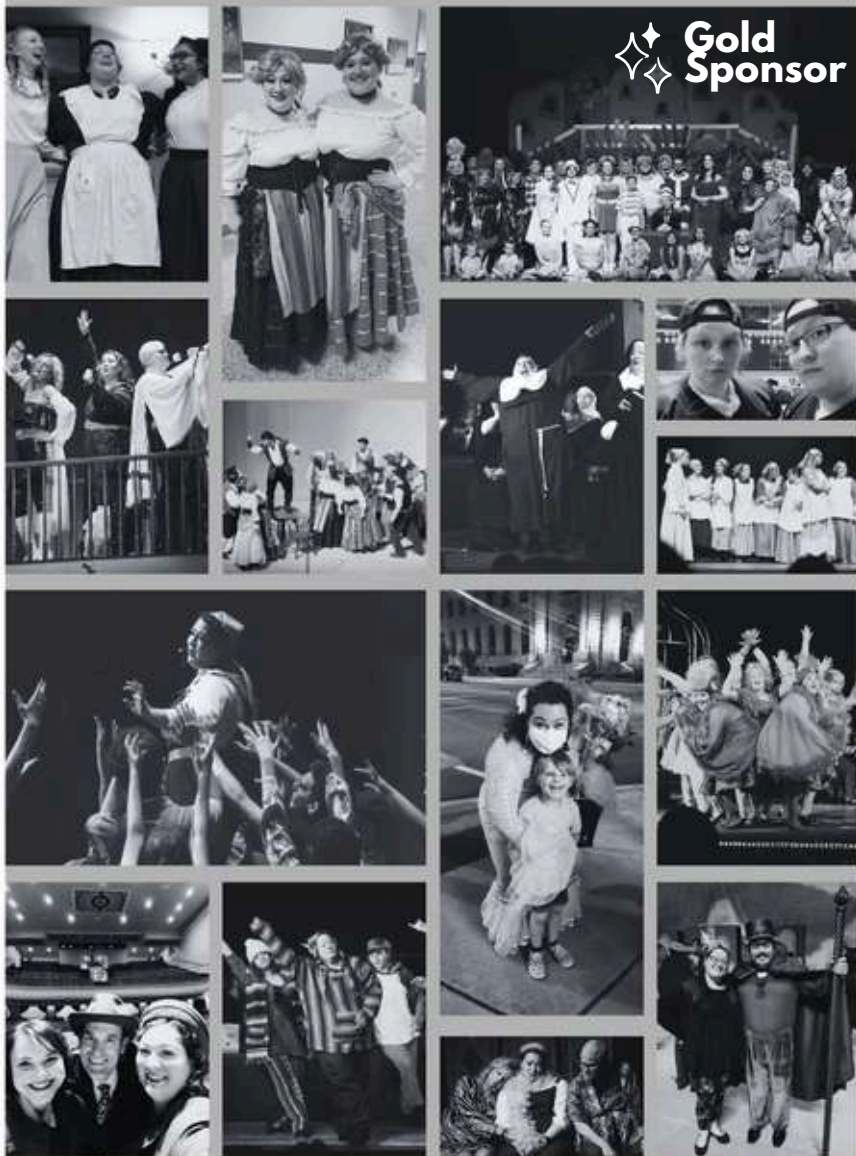
