Kendall Jeonson

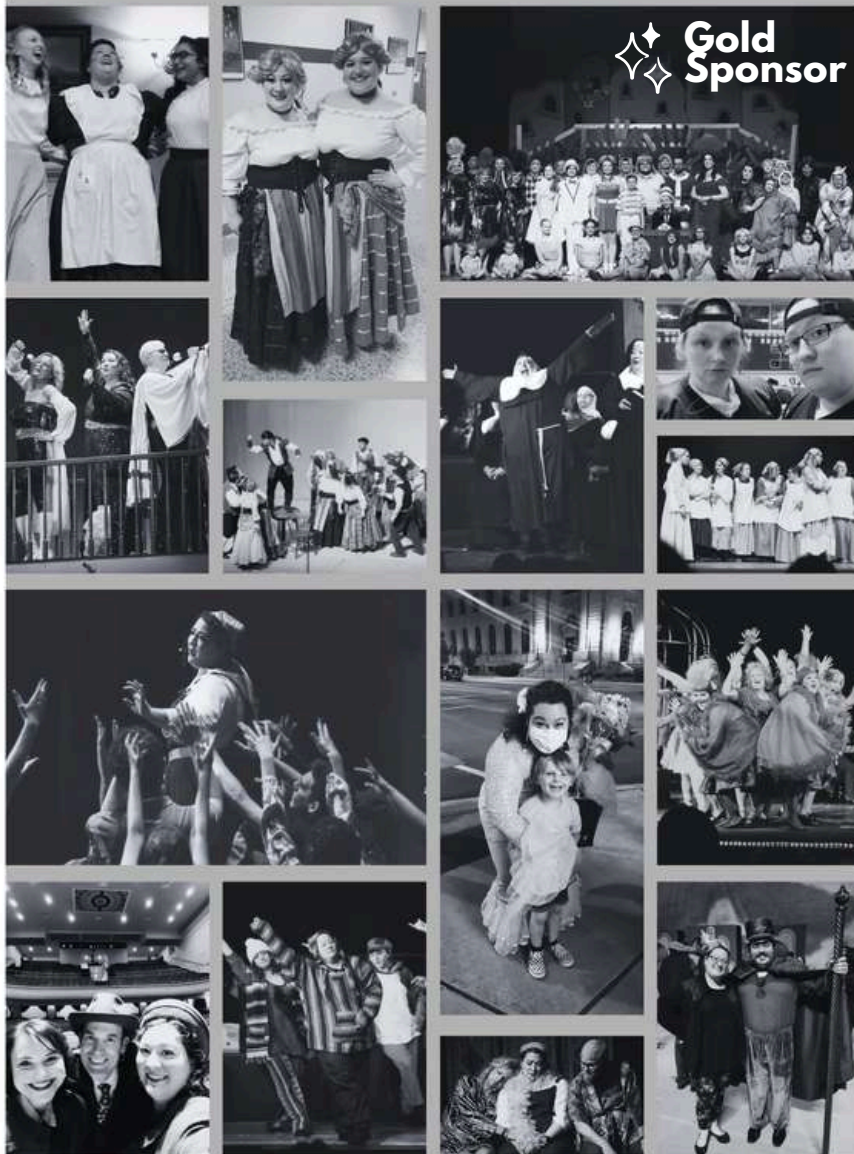
Joseph and the Amazing Technicolor Dreamcoat knows exactly what it is. Bold, playful, unapologetically theatrical. It invites you into a world of bright colors, big storytelling, and larger-than-life fun. I never wanted to sand down the edges of that. The joy of this show is real, and it deserves to be celebrated fully. But I have always believed that joy is most powerful when it is earned. Joseph's journey is not an easy one. He is betrayed by the people who were supposed



to love him, stripped of everything, and forced to find himself again in the dark. By the time the celebration arrives at the end, it is not just spectacle. It is release. It is survival. It is what it sounds like when someone makes it through. We leaned into the bigness of this show at every chance, because the moments of stillness, and there are a few, hit harder when everything around them is so alive. We are living in a moment that can feel heavy and uncertain. I don't think theatre's job is to pretend otherwise. But I do think there is something genuinely necessary about coming together in a room and choosing joy. Not as escape. As an act of faith that delight is still possible, that community is still real, and that a story about survival and forgiveness and color and music is exactly what we need right now. At its heart, *Joseph* is a story about holding on. To your dreams. To your sense of self. To hope, even when hope feels unreasonable. Thank you for being here to share in it.

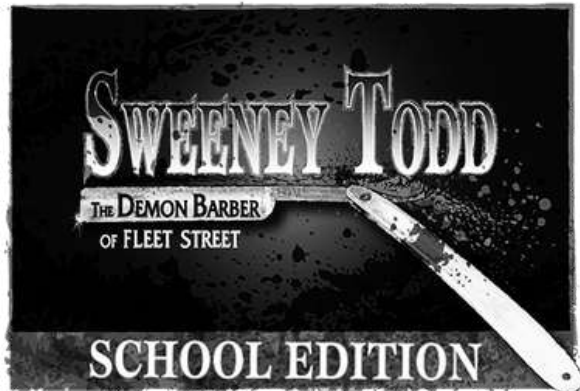

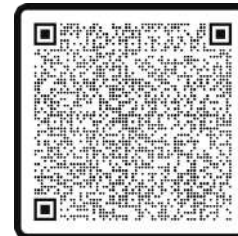

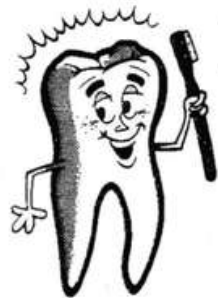
